

RESOLUTION NO. 15-39

A RESOLUTION REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 08-03 REGARDING THE
STREET LIGHT POLICY

Whereas, Ham Lake City Code Article 10-430 G. Street lighting states that placement shall be established by resolution of the City Council ; and


WHEREAS, the cost of initial construction and power costs for the first three years after platting is paid to the City at the time of plat execution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish a policy for the placement of other street lights;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HAM LAKE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. All new subdivisions shall include the installation of one street light at each intersection, at the end of each cul-de-sac, on sharp curves, and with intervening placement at approximately (300 ft. or 600 ft.) intervals.
2. Generally, the light fixtures shall be 100 watt HPS semi cut-off fixtures on black fiberglass poles. Street lights at intersections with State, County, or Municipal State Aid streets will be 150 watt HPS semi cut-off fixtures. Custom styles may be considered on a case-by-case basis. However, at a minimum the fixture must be a semi cut-off style.
3. Construction costs shall be reimbursed by the developer. The power cost for the first three years shall be based on \$255 per light for 100 watt fixtures and \$300 per light for 150 watt fixtures, and shall be paid by the developer at the time of final plat approval.
4. The City may install street lights at T-intersections of State, County, and Municipal State Aid roads at City cost or other intersections as approved on a case by case basis.
